SUMMARY OF POSITION: Performs skilled work in the operations, maintenance and repair of the Wastewater Treatment process and instrumentation, including but not limited to, electric motors and controls, pumps, pipes, and valves of Wastewater Treatment Plant. Inspects and maintains pump stations. Requires participation in the on-call rotation as part of regular job assignment.

QUALIFICATIONS & EXPERIENCE: High school graduation or completion of vocational program in water, wastewater, plumbing, electrical or mechanical repair preferred. Two (2) years of wastewater treatment plant operation experience preferred. (Applicants with this experience given preference.) Bachelors or Associates degree highly preferred.

LICENSE: Possession of or ability to obtain within 18 months from initial date of employment a Class II Operator in Training Certification from State of Connecticut Department of Environmental Protection. Must obtain full Class II Wastewater Treatment Plant Operator Certification within 2 ½ years from initial date of employment. Employees assigned to operations section must obtain Class III Wastewater Treatment Plant Operator Certification from the Department of Environmental Protection within 5 years from initial date of employment.

Must hold a valid Commercial Driver's License with air brake endorsement or be able to obtain within 90 days of employment.
