Experience: water or sewer system maintenance experience. Equivalent construction experience may be substituted for minimum experience required. One year's experience operating heavy construction equipment.

License: Must hold valid Class B Commercial Driver's License with air brake endorsement. Water distribution system certificate as issued by State of Connecticut Department of Public Health at the class of the distribution system (Class 2 or 3), or a sanitary sewer collection system certification desirable.
